Physical Therapy

Physical Therapy helps children and adults improve strength, coordination and flexibility. We provide therapy to children of all ages who have a variety of deficits and developmental delays. We assist adults recovering from a wide range of functional impairments, including, but not limited to:

Occupational Therapy

Our Speech/Language Pathologists will assist you if you have difficulty with communication, thinking, memory, and voice problems. They also work on improving:

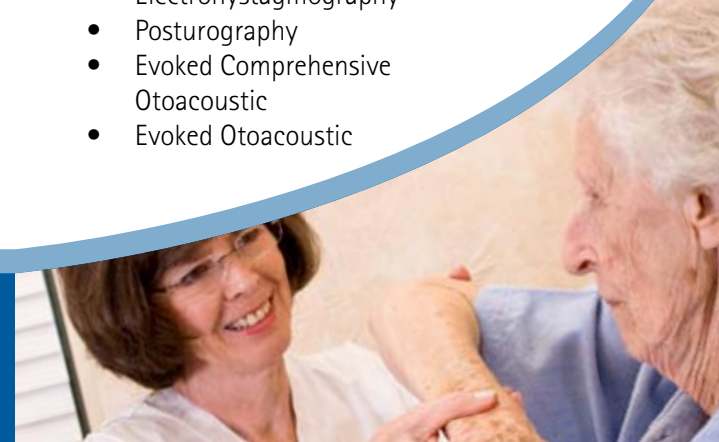
- Oral motor skills
